The P&C's **AGM** will be held at **7pm** on 28th February in the school staff room. All welcome.

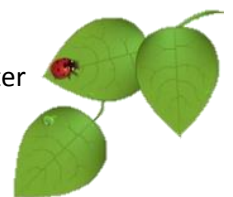

The **Positive Behaviour Support Committee** is a team of parents and staff members who will lead and foster a whole school culture to support behaviour and wellbeing throughout our school community.

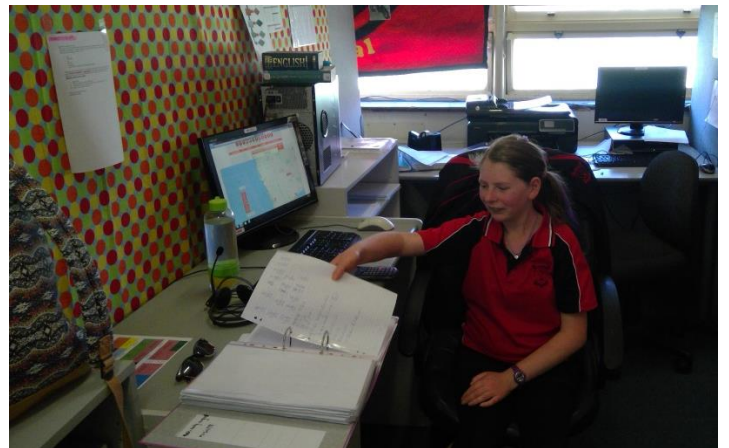
