Opportunities for Secondary students

At Beverley DHS we are keen to ensure that appropriate opportunities are available for our secondary students who wish to pursue vocational (trades) courses in senior secondary school or traineeships or apprenticeships when they leave school. We are excited to be offering a **Certificate 1 in Construction** to eligible Year 10 students with training and assessment provided by VETIS Consulting. Students will complete theory and practical learning, attain a white card, and earn credit towards their WA Certificates of Education. This program is in addition to opportunities for workplace learning provided next semester.
